Will the Minister of TEXTILES वस्त्र मंत्री  
be pleased to state :

- (a) the details of the current status of the Power Tex India scheme which was launched in April 2017 with an outlay of Rs. 487 crore for three years;
- (b) whether it is a fact that an additional amount of Rs. 33.27 crore was received by the Ministry of Textiles for the Power Tex India scheme in 2017-18 in the form of Supplementary Demands for Grants and if so, the details thereof;
- (c) whether the scheme has been successful in achieving its specific agenda of attracting investment of Rs. 1000 crores and employment to 10000 persons in the power-loom sector promising higher returns to power-loom units after five years of its initiation and if so, the State-wise details thereof;
- (d) if not, the reasons therefor; and
- (e) whether there has been any recent shift in agenda or any change involved in investment patterns after the Covid-19 pandemic, if so, the details thereof?

**(a):** The PowerTex India Scheme launched in April 2017 ended on 31.3.2021. The rollover liabilities of few sub-components of PowerTex India scheme viz. (i) In-situ Upgradation fund Scheme, (ii) Group Workshed Scheme, (iii) Prime Minister Credit Fund scheme-standup India, have been subsumed under newly approved Textile Cluster Development Scheme (TCDS) with effect from 1.4.2021 onwards for meeting the committed liabilities only.

**(b):** No additional fund under PowerTex India scheme was received in 2017-18 in the form of supplementary Demand for Grants.

**(c) to (e):** State-wise, five years details of estimated employment generated and investment attracted is at Annexure. There was no significant shift in agenda or any change involved in investment patterns after the COVID 19.
