Will the Minister of COMMUNICATIONS be pleased to state:

- (a) whether the Government is considering to provide high speed internet in rural areas and if so, the details thereof; and
- (b) whether the Government has set any goal under the said policy and if so, the details thereof including in the State of Bihar particularly in Katihar district?

ANSWER MINISTER OF STATE FOR COMMUNICATIONS (SHRI DEVUSINH CHAUHAN)

(a) & (b) BharatNet project is being implemented in all the Gram Panchayats (GPs) and villages of the country including Bihar to provide high speed internet/broadband. As on 28.11.2022, a total of 1,84,399 Gram Panchayats have been made service ready in the country with broadband infrastructure under BharatNet. In Bihar, out of 8404 GPs, a total of 8316 GPs have been made service ready including 233 in Katihar district.
