- (c) whether the Government is likely to restore the concession to senior citizens in the wake of increase in the revenue of passenger segment?

STATEMENT REFERRED TO IN REPLY TO PARTS (a) TO (c) OF THE UNSTARRED QUESTION NO. 2425 BY SHRI S. VENKATESAN TO BE ANSWERED IN LOK SABHA ON 21.12.2022 REGARDING REVENUE FROM PASSENGER SEGMENT

- (a) & (b) To end of November, 2022, Indian Railways has achieved 70.7% of Passenger revenue target and 62.9% of Freight revenue target set in Budget Estimates 2022-23. Passenger Revenue to end of November, 2022, has grown by ₹ 17,851 crore (76.02% growth) over corresponding period of previous year. Similarly, Freight revenue to end of November, 2022, has grown by ₹ 14,443 crore (16.15% growth) over corresponding period of previous year.
- (c) Government gave subsidy of ₹ 59,837 crore on passenger tickets in 2019-20. This amounts to concession of 53% on an average, to every person, travelling on Railways. This subsidy is continuing for all passengers. Further concessions beyond this subsidy amount are continuing for many categories like Divyangjans, students and patients.
