UNIVERSAL ACCESS LEVY

2435. SHRI KARTI P. CHIDAMBARAM:

Will the Minister of COMMUNICATIONS be pleased to state:

(a) the details of the Universal Access Levy (UAL) collected in FYs 2014-15 to 2021-22 as well as provisional data for the current FY;

(b) the details of UAL credited to Universal Service Obligation Fund (USOF) in FYs 2014-15 to 2021-22 and provisional data for the current FY, year-wise;

(c) the details of funds under USOF allocated and utilised in FYs 2014-15 to 2021-22 and provisional data for the current FY, project-wise and State/UT-wise;

(d) the details of status of various projects for which funds have been disbursed through USOF;

(e) whether the USOF funds are diverted towards other purposes or schemes, if so, the details thereof; and

(f) whether the Government intends to reduce the Universal Service Obligation Levy as recommended by TRAI and telecommunication industry stakeholders, if so, the details thereof and if not, the reasons therefor?

ANSWER MINISTER OF STATE FOR COMMUNICATIONS (SHRI DEVUSINH CHAUHAN)

(a) Rs. 75,386 crore is collected as Universal Access Levy (UAL) during Financial Years (FYs) 2014-15 to 2021-22 and current FY 2022-23 at the end of November 2022.

(b) The funds for Universal Service Obligation Fund (USOF) are credited through budgetary provision. The year-wise details of Universal Access Levy (UAL) credited to Universal Service Obligation Fund (USOF) during FYs 2014-15 to 2021-22 and provisional data for the current FY 2022-23 upto November 2022 is given in **Annexure-I.**

(c) The Project-wise details of funds allocated/utilised/disbursed from Universal Service Obligation Fund (USOF) during FYs 2014-15 to 2021-22 and current FY 2022-23 upto November, 2022 is given in **Annexure-II.** The State/UT-wise details of funds allocated/utilised/disbursed from Universal Service Obligation Fund (USOF) during FYs 2014-15 to 2021-22 and current FY 2022-23 upto November, 2022 is given in **Annexure-III.**

(d) The Status of Projects /Schemes of USOF is given in Annexure-IV.

(e) USO Funds are used for providing telecom services in rural and remote areas of the country at affordable and reasonable prices and not for other purposes.

(f) In 2015, Telecom Regulatory Authority of India (TRAI) recommended that component of USOF levy should be reduced from 5% to 3% of Adjusted Gross Revenue (AGR) for all licences with effect from 1st April 2015. However, the recommendation of TRAI was not accepted considering the revised and expanded targets of USOF.
