(a) to (c): Government is implementing various schemes/ programmes on pan India basis for overall development of textile sector including in the State of Maharashtra viz. Production Linked Incentive (PLI) Scheme for Textiles, Pradhan Mantri Mega Integrated Textile Region and Apparel Parks (PM-MITRA), National Technical Textile Mission (NTTM), Silk Samagra, Amended Technology Upgradation Fund Scheme (ATUFS), SAMARTH–Scheme for Capacity Building in Textiles Sector, Integrated Processing Development Scheme, Scheme for Integrated Textile Parks, Scheme for Development of Jute Sector, Integrated Wool Development Programme, Power Tex, Textile Cluster Development Scheme, Schemes under Handloom Sector & Schemes under Handicrafts Sector etc.

Funds are not earmarked /allocated to the States under various schemes and expenditure is incurred on the basis of merits of proposal received from all across the country. The details of Budget Estimates (BE) during last three years and current year under various schemes of Ministry of Textiles are given at Annexure. Direct employment in Textiles sector is estimated around at 45 million.
