SCHEME TO PROMOTE PRODUCTS OF TECHNICAL TEXTILES

- (a) whether the Government has approved the Production Linked Incentive (PLI) Scheme for Textiles to promote production of MMF Apparel, MMF Fabrics and Products of Technical Textiles in the country to enable Textile sector to achieve size and scale and to become competitive and if so, the details thereof;
- (b) the details of the impact of this scheme on the targeted districts of the Country;
- (c) whether the Government has been succeeded in PLI scheme focus on Manade Fiber (MMF) apparel, MMF Fabrics and Products of technical textiles to enhance country's manufacturing capabilities and exports;
- (d) whether West Bengal is included in this scheme, if so, the details thereof, State and UT-Wise along with the future initiatives for its progress; and
- (e) if not, the reasons therefor?

(a) to (e): Government has approved the Production Linked Incentive (PLI) Scheme on 08.09.2021 with an approved outlay of Rs.10,683 crore over a five year period to promote production of MMF Apparel, MMF Fabrics and Products of Technical Textiles in the country to enable Textiles Industry to achieve size and scale and to become competitive. The selected 64 applicants have proposed investment of Rs. 19,798 crore and employment of around 2.45 lakhs persons. The PLI Scheme for Textiles is being implemented on pan India basis including West Bengal. The selected companies will be eligible to get incentives on achieving the threshold investment and threshold/incremental turnover.
