- (a) the details of new godowns under construction in the Country, district and State-wise;**
- (b) the details of rice unfit for human consumption being used to produce Ethanol during the last three years and the current year, year, State and district-wise; and**
- (c) the details of anticipated rice unfit for human consumption available for Ethanol and other purposes in the coming five years, year, State, district and distillery-wise?**

**(a): The details of new godowns under construction by Food Corporation of India (FCI) under various Scheme is as given below:-**

**(i): Private Entrepreneurs Guarantee (PEG) Scheme: As on 01.12.2022, 37 nos. of godowns are under construction in Private Entrepreneurs Guarantee (PEG) Scheme. The details are at Annexure -I.**

**(ii) Central Sector Scheme (CSS) "Storage & Godowns": As of 30.11.2022, under Central Sector Scheme there are 5 Godowns under construction in North East region and 5 Godowns are under construction in Other than North East. The details are at Annexure - II.**

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**(iii) Silo:** In order to upgrade and modernize the storage facilities, Government of India approved Action Plan for construction of steel silos on PPP (Public Private Partnership) mode in the country. Under this plan Silos with capacity of 15.5 LMT at 31 locations are under various stages of development. The details are at Annexure – III.

Besides that Central Warehousing Corporation (CWC) is also constructing a capacity of 384256 MT. The details are at Annexure – IV.

**(b) & (c):** The Government is not supplying any quantity of rice unfit for human consumption for the production of ethanol. The entrepreneurs willing to produce ethanol from Damaged Food Grains (DFGs) like broken rice, can purchase the DFGs like broken rice from open market to produce ethanol. However, the supply of ethanol produced from DFGs like broken rice and maize to Oil Marketing Companies (OMCs) in Ethanol Supply Year (ESY) (Dec-Nov) 2019-20, 2020-21 & 2021-22 (as on 13.11.2022) is 15.08 crore litres, 39.3 crore litres and 21.36 crore litres, respectively. In order to achieve the 20% blending target by 2025, about 1350 crore liters of ethanol will be required (1016 crore liters for blending and 334 crore liters for other industrial uses) for which the Government has estimated the requirement of approximate 670 crore litres of grain based ethanol. However, the grain based ethanol is not estimated individually for either of DFGs like broken rice or maize or surplus rice available with FCI. Moreover, grain based ethanol production is entirely market driven as it depends upon the market situations prevailing at that time.
