Allocation of Funds to Maharashtra

SHRI KRUPAL BALAJI TUMANE:

Will the Minister of JAL SHAKTI be pleased to state:

- (a) whether the Government of Maharashtra is coordinating with the Union Government for the implementation of Jal Jeevan Mission (JJM) and if so, the details thereof;
- (b) the details of funds allocated to Maharashtra under the Mission since its inception; and
- (c) the ranking of Maharashtra in terms of supplying piped drinking water to every household under the said Mission?

ANSWER

(SHRI PRAHLAD SINGH PATEL)

- (a) Yes. Since inception of the JJM i.e. August 2019, Government of India in partnership with States, is implementing Jal Jeevan Mission (JJM) – Har Ghar Jal to make provision of tap water supply to every rural household of the country including those of Maharashtra, by 2024.

At the time of announcement of Jal Jeevan Mission, 48.44 lakh (33.21%) rural households in Maharashtra, were reported to have tap water connections. Since then, tap water connections have been provided to additional 56.98 lakh rural households in the State. As on 18.12.2022, out of total 145.87 lakh rural households in Maharashtra, provision of tap water supply has been made to 105.42 lakh (72.27%) households.

- (b) The year-wise details of funds allocated, released and utilized by Maharashtra under Jal Jeevan Mission (JJM) for 2019-20, 2020-21, 2021-22 and 2022-23 are as under:
