**WATER CONNECTIONS UNDER JJM**

Will the Minister of JAL SHAKTI be pleased to state:-

- (a) the number of rural households which have been provided with drinking water connections under the Jal Jeevan Mission (JJM) in Gujarat;
- (b) the amount fixed for public participation and per household contribution for the rural household of Scheduled Caste/Scheduled Tribe majority areas, Aborigines in desert areas and in famine affected areas for Har Ghar Nal connections; and
- (c) the time limit set to provide Har Ghar Nal connection to every household in rural areas under the Jal Jeevan Mission (JJM)?

**ANSWER**

(a) to (c) Jal Jeevan Mission (JJM), a centrally sponsored scheme, is being implemented in partnership with States, since August, 2019 to make provision of potable tap water supply to every rural household of the country on regular and long-term basis, by 2024.

As reported by the State Government on JJM-IMIS, All 91.73 Lakh (100%) rural households in Gujarat have been provided with tap water connection, of which about 26.57 lakh connections have been provided under the Jal Jeevan Mission.

As per provisions of operational guidelines for the implementation of JJM, for in-village piped water supply infrastructure and related source development to be implemented by Gram Panchayat and/ or its sub-committee, i.e. VWSC/ Pani Samiti/ User Group, etc., communities contribute 5% of the capital cost in cash and/ or kind and/ or labour in hilly and forested areas, NE and Himalayan States and villages having more than 50% SCs and/or STs population; and 10% of the capital cost in other villages.

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
