#### FINANCIAL FUNDING SCHEMES

### 2679. SHRI SISIR KUMAR ADHIKARI:

Will the Minister of MICRO, SMALL AND MEDIUM ENTERPRISES be pleased to state:

- (a) whether it is a fact that Micro, Small and Medium Enterprises (MSMEs) sector contributes thirty per cent to the GDP of the country;
- (b) if so, the details of registered MSMEs, as on November, 2022, therefor, State-wise; and
- (c) the details of financial funding schemes and the Government support norms including the Credit Guarantee Fund Trust for Micro and Small Enterprises (CGTMSE) support facilities to new startups or MSMEs thereof?

#### **ANSWER**

# MINISTER OF STATE FOR MICRO, SMALL AND MEDIUM ENTERPRISES (SHRI BHANU PRATAP SINGH VERMA)

- (a): As per the latest information received from Ministry of Statistics & Programme Implementation, the share of Gross Value Added (GVA) of MSME sector in all India GDP during 2019-20 and 2020-21 were 30.50% and 26.83% respectively.
- (b): As per Udyam Registration Portal, total number of micro, small and medium enterprises registered in all India as on 30.11.2022 was 1,23,02,670. The State/UT wise details are attached as annexure-I.
- (c): Ministry of Micro, Small and Medium Enterprises (MSME), Government of India launched the Credit Guarantee Scheme (CGS) to strengthen credit delivery system and facilitate the flow of credit to the Micro & Small Enterprises (MSE) sector without the hassles of collateral and third-party guarantee. Under the Scheme, Credit Guarantee is given to the Member Lending Institutions (MLIs) for loans up to Rs. 200 lakh granted to MSE without collateral and third-party guarantee.

The Emergency Credit Line Guarantee Scheme (ECLGS) was announced as part of the Aatma Nirbhar Bharat Package in May, 2020 to support eligible MSMEs and other business enterprises to meet their operational liabilities and resume businesses in view of the distress caused by the COVID-19 crisis. This scheme covers all the sectors of the economy. Under this, 100% guarantee is provided to Member Lending Institutions (MLIs) in respect of the credit facility extended by them to eligible borrowers.

The Government of India has announced Fund of Funds with the nomenclature Self Reliant India (SRI) Fund to infuse Rs. 50,000 crore as equity funding in those MSMEs which have the potential and viability to grow and become large units. Under this scheme total size of fund of Rs. 50,000 Crore has a provision of Rs.10,000 Crore from Government of India and Rs.40,000 Crore leverage through Private Equity / Venture Capital funds.
