Will the Minister for HOUSING AND URBAN AFFAIRS be pleased to state:

- (a) the number of public toilets constructed under Swachh Bharat Mission (SBM) in Andhra Pradesh during the last three years;
- (b) the funds allocated, disbursed and utilized for the said State under the mission during the said period;
- (c) whether it is a fact the lack of adequate public toilets in the country leading to poor sanitation; and
- (d) if so, the details thereof?

(c) & (d): Swachh Bharat Mission – Urban (SBM – U) was launched on 2nd October, 2014 with one of the objectives being to make the urban areas Open Defecation Free (ODF). This has been achieved with the construction of 62,79,304 Individual Household Latrine (IHHL) units and construction of 6,27,385 Community Toilet/Public Toilet (CT/PT) seats under the Mission. To strengthen and sustain sanitation outcomes, every city goes through a third party verification process that leads to ODF/ODF+/ODF++/Water Plus outcomes. To improve the operation and maintenance of Public and Community Toilets, a six week Toilet 2.0 Campaign has been launched on 19th November, 2022.
