#### 2723. SHRI A. GANESHAMURTHI:

#### Will the Minister of ROAD TRANSPORT AND HIGHWAYS

#### be pleased to state:

- (a) whether the Government is constructing Greenfield expressways in the country;
- (b) if so, the details thereof along with the corridors identified;
- (c) whether Bengaluru-Chennai expressway is proposed to be made Greenfield expressway and if so, the details thereof;
- (d) whether these Greenfield expressways are part of the integrated planning and implementation of infrastructure connectivity projects for industrial clusters; and
- (e) if so, the cost of these projects and the time schedule fixed for the purpose?

#### **ANSWER**

## THE MINISTER OF ROAD TRANSPORT AND HIGHWAYS (SHRI NITIN JAIRAM GADKARI)

- (a) Yes, Sir. The Government of India has envisaged 5 Greenfield Expressways and 22 Access Controlled Corridors with an overall length of 9,860 kms.
- (b) The details of the corridors are annexed.
- (c) Yes, Sir. The 262 km long Bengaluru-Chennai Expressway is part of the 5 Greenfield Expressways being developed by the Government. The Total Capital Cost of the corridor is Rs. 16,730 Cr. and the entire corridor has been awarded for construction.

(d) & (e) These 27 Greenfield Expressways and Access Controlled Corridors are part of the integrated planning and implementation of infrastructure connectivity projects for industrial clusters and enhance connectivity to economic centers & economic nodes by connecting 353 nodes under National Master Plan and 20 Multi Modal Logistic Parks and other transport infrastructure like 29 ports, 85+ Airports and 170+ Major Railway Stations. The project is targeted for completion by FY 2027-28.
