#### **CONSTRUCTION OF NATIONAL HIGHWAYS**

### 313. SHRI CHANDRA SEKHAR SAHU: SHRI GIRISH BHALCHANDRA BAPAT:

#### **WILL THE MINISTER OF ROAD TRANSPORT AND HIGHWAYS**

#### be pleased to state:

- (a) whether the Government has set up a target to construct 40 kilometers of National Highway (NH) every day in the current financial year and if so, the extent to which it has been achieved so far;
- (b) whether the Government has identified projects which help to provide logistic efficiency to the Indian economy and if so, the details thereof, State-wise, particularly in Maharashtra and Odisha;
- (c) whether the Government has identified congestion points and economic centres which have huge traffic flow amongst them for efficient and smooth road connectivity;
- (d) if so, the details thereof, State-wise, particularly in Maharashtra and Odisha; and
- (e) whether the Government proposes to securitise some NHs and Expressways and if so, the details thereof, State-wise?

#### THE MINISTER OF ROAD TRANSPORT AND HIGHWAYS

#### (SHRI NITIN JAIRAM GADKARI)

- (a) Ministry has set a target of constructing 12,200 km National Highways during 2022-23, against which 4766 km has been constructed till November, 2022.
- (b) Under Bharatmala Pariyojana, apart from development of

Highways/Expressways in the country which facilitate logistic efficiency to India economy, 35 Multi Modal Logistics Parks (MMLPs) are to be developed. These MMLPs would act as major cargo consolidation and distribution hubs. The implementation of Bharatmala Pariyojana along with 35 MMLPs in the country is expected to further increase the logistics efficiency. The List of 35 MMLPs approved under Bharatmala Pariyojana, State-wise including Maharashtra and Odisha, is enclosed as Annexure I.

- (c) & (d) Under Bharatmala Pariyojana 191 such points of congestion were identified on the entire network. Of the 191 choke points, de-congestion projects have already been completed in 56 congestion points and de-congestion projects are under implementation in 83 congestion points. The work on remaining 52 congestions points will be awarded for construction by FY 2024-25. The status of congestion points and its improvement across the country including in the State of Maharashtra & Odisha is enclosed as Annexure II.
- (e) No proposal has been approved so far to securitise NHs and Expressways.
