NAMAMI GANGE PROGRAMME IN RAJASTHAN

Will the Minister of JAL SHAKTI be pleased to state:-

- (a) the funds sanctioned by the Government under Namami Gange Programme during the last three years in Bihar and Rajasthan;
- (b) the quantum of funds spent till date, year and State-wise particularly in Bihar and Rajasthan;
- (c) the details of the projects initiated and completed under the said Programme till date in Bihar and Rajasthan;
- (d) the cost of the above projects, project-wise; and
- (e) whether there exists a progress report on the Chambal river conservation project under which the Union Government had released approximately Rs. 69 crore to the Government of Rajasthan and if so, the details thereof and if not, the reasons therefor?

ANSWER

THE MINISTER OF STATE FOR JAL SHAKTI (SHRI BISHWESWAR TUDU)

(a) There is no state-wise sanction of funds under Namami Gange Programme. The funds released to various agencies for implementation of projects in Bihar and Rajasthan under Namami Gange Programme, during the last three Financial Years and in current Financial Year (2022-23) till 31 October 2022, are as under:-

(b) Namami Gange Programme was launched in June 2014 for a period up to 31st March, 2021 to rejuvenate River Ganga and its tributaries. The programme was subsequently extended up to 31stMarch, 2026.

The amount released/expended by NMCG to various agencies for implementation of projects, compiled State-wise, from 2014-15 up to 31st October, 2022, is as under:

SMCG-Bihar has reported an expenditure of Rs.2,267.11 crore during the said period. So far as Rajasthan is concerned, NMCG has been providing financial assistance for the project 'Environmental Improvement plan of River Chambal at Kota, Rajasthan', since 2016-17. As per Utilization Certificate (up-to 31 July 2022) furnished by Urban Improvement Trust, Kota, the project also received Rs. 40.00 crore from M/o Environment, Forest & Climate Change during 2009-10 and 2010-11. The expenditure against central share for the project, as per the said Utilization Certificate, isRs. 92.54 crore.

(c) Under Namami Gange comprehensive set of interventions in the areas of wastewater treatment, solid waste management, river front management (ghats and crematoria development), e-flow, afforestation, biodiversity conservation and Public Participation etc. are being taken up for the rejuvenation of river Ganga.

The status of projects taken up under Namami Gange Programme in Bihar and Rajasthan are placed in Annexure-I.

- (d) The cost of sewerage management projects in Bihar and Rajasthan is enclosed at Annexure-I.
- (e) Under Namami Gange Programme, one project at the cost of Rs. 258.48 Crore has been taken up in Kota, Rajasthan for the conservation of river Chambal. The project is being implemented by Urban Improvement Trust (UIT), Kota. The project is currently under implementation and has achieved the physical progress of 73.32% and an expenditure of 133.87 crore has been incurred till October, 2022.

Out of these 10 projects have been completed thereby creating 233.5 MLD STP capacity and laying of 724 km of sewerage network.

- i) 55 ghats and 10 crematoria have been taken up at a cost of Rs.516.23 crore, out of which 46 ghats and 4 crematoria have been completed.
- ii) 296527 no. of individual household's latrines (IHHLs) have been constructed for which Rs.256.76 crore has been released. All the 472 villages along the banks of river Ganga in Bihar have been declared as Open Defecation Free (ODF) villages.
- iii) Under afforestation 6 projects have been taken at a cost of Rs. 129.57 crore, out of which 5 projects have been completed.
- iv) Under solid waste management 1 project for river surface cleaning has been taken up at a cost of Rs.3.96 crore. The project has been completed.

II) Rajasthan

Sewerage management project has been taken up with a sanctioned cost of Rs.258.48 crore for creation of 36 MLD STP capacity and laying of 146 km sewerage network. The project is under implementation and so far 30 MLD STP capacity has been created and laying of 107 km of sewerage network.
