## **Consumption of Kerosene**

Will the Minister of PETROLEUM AND NATURAL GAS be pleased to state:

- (a) the details of year-on-year percentage change in consumption of kerosene during the last three years in the country, especially in Uttar Pradesh; and
- (b) the details of percentage of households falling 'Above Poverty Line' and the percentage of households falling 'Below Poverty Line' that are still using kerosene in the State of Uttar Pradesh?

## MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF PETROLEUM & NATURAL GAS (SHRI RAMESWAR TELI)

(a) Government of India makes allocation of Public Distribution System (PDS) Kerosene to States/UTs on quarterly basis for cooking and lighting purpose. PDS Kerosene allocation to States/UTs have been rationalized since 2010- 11 taking into account, factors such as increase in domestic LPG/PNG connections, electricity coverage, non-lifting of PDS Kerosene quota by the concerned States/UTs etc. As on date, 11 States/UTs including Uttar Pradesh have declared themselves as Kerosene free.

Details of percentage change in consumption of PDS Kerosene in the country and Uttar Pradesh during the last three years is given below:
