MSME SCHEME IN ANDHRA PRADESH

357. SHRI ADALA PRABHAKARA REDDY:

Will the Minister of MICRO, SMALL AND MEDIUM ENTERPRISES be pleased to state :

- (a) the number of beneficiaries under MSME scheme in Andhra Pradesh, particularly women, under the component – Skill Upgradation and Mahila Coir Yojana, district-wise;
- (b) the funds spent under the said scheme in the State of Andhra Pradesh, component-wise; and
- (c) the measures being taken to ensure convergence between SFURTI and Coir Vikas Yojana?

(a) & (b): Coir Board is implementing Skill Upgradation and Mahila Coir Yojana for promotion and development of Coir Industry all over the country including Andhra Pradesh under the Umbrella Scheme – Coir Vikas Yojana. There are total 2808 beneficiaries, among them 2315 are women beneficiaries trained/undergone various training programmes conducted by Coir Board in the State of Andhra Pradesh under the Scheme from 2019-20 onwards.

The district-wise details of training/ programmes indicating the number of beneficiaries and the funds spent under the component in the State of Andhra Pradesh during the last three years and current year (up to 30.11.2022) are at **Annexure**.

(c): Under the Coir Vikas Yojana, Skill Upgradation & Mahila Coir Yojana, Awareness Programmes and Workshop are being undertaken. The beneficiaries under the Scheme while giving the training Programme will get more Skill for the production of Value added Coir Products and also given awareness about the SFURTI Scheme. These beneficiaries are promoted to avail the benefit of SFURTI Scheme. Accordingly at present three Coir SFURTI Clusters have been sanctioned in the state of Andhra Pradesh, that is at Viziayanagaram, Kadiyapulanka and Amalapuram. Out of which Viziayanagaram and Kadiyapulanka are functional and Amalapuram is under implementation
