PMEGP IN MAHARASHTRA

364. SHRI SADASHIV KISAN LOKHANDE:

Will the Minister of MICRO, SMALL AND MEDIUM ENTERPRISES be pleased to state:

- (a) whether work is being done in the country under the Prime Minister's Employment Generation Programme (PMEGP);
- (b) if so, the details thereof, particularly in the Shirdi Parliamentary Constituency in Maharashtra and its status as on date; and
- (c) the details of Central funds allocated as on date for said programme during the last three years, year-wise, along with its utilisation and number of beneficiaries under the programme, State-wise?

ANSWER

(a) & (b): Yes, Sir. Ministry of MSME, through Khadi and Village Industries Commission (KVIC), is implementing Prime Minister's Employment Generation Programme (PMEGP) for generating self employment opportunities in the country by setting up micro-enterprises in non-farm sector. The scheme is providing continuous and sustainable employment to a large segment of traditional artisans and rural and urban unemployed youth so as to arrest migration of rural youth to urban areas. Under PMEGP, General Category beneficiaries can avail of Margin Money (MM) subsidy of 25% of the project cost in rural areas and 15% in urban areas. Beneficiaries belonging to SC/ST/OBC, Women, Ex-Servicemen, Minorities, Differently abled, Transgenders, North Eastern Region, Hill and Border areas, etc., are treated as Special Category and are entitled for higher Margin Money subsidy rate of 35% of the project cost in rural areas and 25% in urban area. The maximum cost of project is Rs.50 lakh in the manufacturing sector and Rs.20 lakh in the service sector.

Since its inception in 2008-09 till 30th November, 2022, about 8.32 lakh units have been assisted with Rs. 20,500 Cr. of Margin Money subsidy, generating estimated employment for about 66 lakh persons across the country.

Performance under PMEGP in Ahmednagar District, Maharashtra, including Parliamentary Constituency of Shirdi, during the last three years and current year is as below:
