Clean Drinking Water in West Bengal

396. SHRI DILIP GHOSH:

Will the Minister of JAL SHAKTI be pleased to state:

- (a) the steps taken by the Government to provide clean drinking water in the country including West Bengal (WB);
- (b) the details of the financial assistance provided to West Bengal under National Rural Drinking Water Programme (NRDWP) or other Centrally Sponsored Schemes during the last five years and the utilisation thereof; and
- (c) the details of central assistance for the Solid and Liquid Waste Management (SLWM) projects during the last five years, in West Bengal along with its utilisation, project and year-wise?

ANSWER

THE MINISTER OF STATE FOR JAL SHAKTI (SHRI PRAHLAD SINGH PATEL)

(a) & (b) Since August 2019, Government of India is implementing Jal Jeevan Mission, in partnership with States after subsuming erstwhile National Rural Drinking Water Programme (NRDWP) to make provision of tap water supply to every rural household, including those in West Bengal, by 2024.

Details of Central fund allocated, fund drawn and fund utilization reported by the State of West Bengal under erstwhile NRDWP in 2017-18 & 2018-19 and under Jal Jeevan Mission in 2019-20, 2020-21, 2021-22 & 2022-23 (as on 05.12.2022) is as under:
