Will the Minister of NEW AND RENEWABLE ENERGY be pleased to state:

- (a) the status of development works done in West Bengal under the scheme of Solar Park and Ultra-Mega Solar Projects during the last two years and the current year;
- (b) the number of approved solar parks and their capacity;
- (c) the implementation status along with future initiatives taken or being taken in this regard; and
- (d) the quantum of funds allocated for the development works under the said scheme during the financial year 2021-22, State/UT-wise including West Bengal?

(a) to (c) One solar park of capacity 125 MW, earlier approved to West Bengal State Electricity Distribution Company Limited (WBSEDCL) in West Bengal, was cancelled on 19.08.2020 due to slow progress. Currently there is no solar park approved in West Bengal under the scheme for Solar Park and Ultra-Mega Solar Projects
