Will the Minister of DEFENCE be pleased to state:

- (a) the number of Sainik/National Military Schools opened during the last five years, State/UT-wise including Maharashtra and funds allocated presently to each school;
- (b) whether the Government has approved the proposal of opening 100 Sainik schools in collaboration with States, Non-Governmental Organizations and private institutions;
- (c) if so, the details thereof and the number of schools opened so far, State/UT-wise including
Osmanabad Constituency of Maharashtra and Kolar in Karnataka;
- (d) the total number of applications received for opening of Sainik Schools and number of those accepted and rejected by the Government / Sainik School Society during the last five years, State/ UT-wise;
- (e) whether Sainik School Authority/Society has entrusted its assessment report to the Government, if so, the details thereof and if not, the time by which it is likely to be submitted; and
- (f) whether the Government proposes to put the upper limit with regard to the total number of Sainik schools running in a State/UT including Dadra and Nagar Haveli and Daman & Diu and if so, the details thereof?

(a): No new Rashtriya Military School has been established during last five years. The details of Sainik Schools opened in the country during last five years is at Annexure-A. The funds allocated to Sainik/Rashtriya Military Schools presently i.e. during 2022-23 is at Annexure-B and Annexure-C, respectively.

(b) to (e): Yes, Sir. The Government has approved an initiative to open New Sainik Schools across the country in partnership mode with NGOs/Private/State Government Schools in all States/UTs including Maharashtra and Karnataka subject to fulfillment of qualifying requirements and signing of the Memorandum of Agreement (MoA) with the Sainik Schools Society. The total number of applications received for opening of New Sainik Schools till date is 467. Sainik Schools Society/Ministry of Defence, after due process of evaluation and approval have signed Memorandum of Agreement (MoA) with 18 Schools. The details of State/UT wise number of New Sainik Schools with whom SSS/Ministry of Defence have signed MoA is at Annexure-D. No School has been opened in Osmanabad Constituency of Maharashtra and Kolar in Karnataka.

(f): No, Sir. There is no upper limit. However, Pro-rata allocation for opening of New Sainik Schools under this initiative has been made keeping in view balanced and equitable distribution among States/UTs.
