Will the Minister of WOMEN AND CHILD DEVELOPMENT be pleased to state:

- (a) whether the Government has the data of budgetary allocation along with the number of beneficiaries under Pradhan Mantri Matru Vandana Yojana, if so, the details thereof, district-wise for Uttar Pradesh and Odisha;
- (b) whether the Government has formulated a detailed plan for dissemination of this scheme to the uneducated rural population, if so, the details thereof;
- (c) whether the Government has quantifiable data to indicate the number of women, district-wise in the said States, who had lost the benefit under the said scheme due to miscarriage or still birth of the child; and
- (d) if so, the details thereof?

ANSWER

MINISTER FOR WOMEN AND CHILD DEVELOPMENT (SHRIMATI SMRITI ZUBIN IRANI)

(a) Funds are released to the State Governments/UT Administrations on the basis basis of indicative targets and utilization of funds. District-wise allocations are not made under the Pradhan Mantri Matru Vandana Yojana (PMMVY). The district-wise details of number of beneficiaries provided maternity benefits under PMMVY in the State of Uttar Pradesh as on 22.11.2022 are at Annexure-I. Government has released Rs 1359 cr to Uttar Pradesh in PMMVY Escrow account till 22.11.2022.

The PMMVY is not being implemented by the State of Odisha.

- (b) The Ministry of Women and Child Development has provided funds under PMMVY to all States/UTs for undertaking information, Education and Communication (IEC) activities in the States/UTs. The ministry also celebrates 'Matru Vandana Saptah' every year to intensify implementation of the scheme and create a healthy competition amongst States/UTs. States/UTs undertake various IEC and Behavior Change Communication (BCC) activities such as Prabhat Pheri, Nukkad Natak, Newspaper Advertisements, Airing Radio Jingles, Selfie Campaign, Door to Door Campaign, Community Programmes at field functionary level etc.
- (c) & (d) Statement showing district-wise number of beneficiaries who had lost the benefit under PMMVY due to miscarriage or still-birth in the State of Uttar Pradesh as on 06.12.2022 is at Annexure-II.
