**CENTRALLY SPONSORED SCHEMES IN JHARKHAND**

**537. SHRI SANJAY SETH:  
SHRI CHANDRA PRAKASH CHOUDHARY:**

Will the Minister of **HEALTH AND FAMILY WELFARE** be pleased to state:

- (a) the details of the centrally sponsored schemes being implemented in the healthcare sector across the country, State/UT-wise including Jharkhand;
- (b) whether the centrally sponsored schemes and central sector schemes have been more rational and effective in streamlining the utilization of the Government expenditure and if so, the details thereof;
- (c) the details of the funds sanctioned for the said schemes during the last three years, State/ UT-wise including Jharkhand;
- (d) the details of the various Non-Governmental Organizations (NGOs) enrolled under/associated with such schemes along with funds allocated to each of them during each of the last three years and the current year, State/UT-wise, including Jharkhand; and
- (e) whether cases of fraudulent activities in the works assigned to such NGOs have been noticed and if so, the details thereof along with corrective steps taken by the Government in this regard?

(a) to (e) Ministry of Health and Family Welfare through various centrally sponsored schemes and central sector schemes supplements the efforts of the States / UTs in the healthcare sector. The details of various schemes / programmes of this Ministry implemented through the States / UTs alongwith details of funds released during last few years is attached at Annexure. Various Central Sector Schemes and Centrally Sponsored Schemes are implemented with separate budget lines for each component of the schemes under this Ministry. Government spending for these schemes are made for best output as per quarterly expenditure plan. Under major Centrally Sponsored Schemes of the Ministry, engagement of the Non-Governmental Organizations (NGOs) is conducted by the States and Districts at local level. All records pertaining to NGOs including funds provided, utilisation of funds and their performance assessment are maintained at the State level. The funds are released to States/UTs on the basis of Utilization Certificate.
