Will the Minister of **HEALTH AND FAMILY WELFARE** be pleased to state:

- (a) whether the National Tele Mental Health Programme has been rolled out in Andhra Pradesh and if so, the details thereof;
- (b) the details of the funds allocated under the Programme in Andhra Pradesh;
- (c) whether the Programme has been rolled out in the entire State and if so, the details thereof;
- (d) the details of the areas where Tele Mental Health Services are unavailable/restricted in Andhra Pradesh; and
- (e) whether the Government proposes to expand the services to 24X7 as opposed to between 0900 hours and 1700 hours and if so, the details thereof?

ANSWER THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF HEALTH AND FAMILY WELFARE (DR. BHARATI PRAVIN PAWAR)

- (a) The National Tele Mental Health Programme has been rolled out in Andhra Pradesh on 11.10.2022. State Tele MANAS cell has been established at Siddhartha Medical College, Vijayawada and the Mentoring Institute for Andhra Pradesh is AIIMS, Mangalagiri.
- (b) The funds released to the State of Andhra Pradesh is Rs. 1,96,87,000/-. Details of funds (in Rs.) may be seen as under:
