- (b) the details of the beneficiaries in Sikar and Alwar in Rajasthan, district-wise;
- (c) whether the Government is aware that several CGHS empanelled hospitals across the country including Rajasthan have stopped providing cashless facilities to CGHS beneficiaries due to pending dues of the Government;
- (d) the list of hospitals whose payment has been put on hold/stopped during 2021-2022; and
- (e) if so, the details thereof along with the measures taken in this regard?
