Will the Minister of **HEALTH AND FAMILY WELFARE** be pleased to state:

- (a) The total number of fully vaccinated people administered with first, second and booster dose in our country as on 15/11/2022;
- (b) The total number of unused vaccines still in Government buffer stock as on 15/11/2022, company-wise; and
- (c) The details of number of vaccines past its expiry date still available in Government stock, company-wise and the amount of those vaccines?

(a) to (c): As on 15<sup>th</sup> November 2022, among all eligible beneficiary from the age group 12 years and above, a total of 102.53 crore 1<sup>st</sup> dose, 95.06 crore 2<sup>nd</sup> dose and 22.22 crore precaution doses have been administered across the country.

As on 15<sup>th</sup> November 2022, the vaccines available with States/UTs is at Annexure-1. As per CoWIN there are no vaccine past its expiry date in Government buffer stock.
