STATEMENT REFERRED TO IN REPLY TO PARTS (a) TO (d) OF UNSTARRED QUESTION NO. 65 BY SHRI RAMCHARAN BOHRA AND SHRI RAHUL KASWAN TO BE ANSWERED IN LOK SABHA ON 07.12.2022 REGARDING SURVEY OF RAILWAY LINES IN RAJASTHAN

(a) to (c): Railway projects are not sanctioned State-wise/district-wise/ tehsil-wise, but sanctioned Zone-wise as Indian Railways' network may span across various State boundaries.

Surveys for 07 new line projects covering length of 524 km falling fully/partly in the State of Rajasthan have been taken up to improve and extend the railway network in Rajasthan. The details are as under:-

6.	Devgarh-Madariya to Bar	92

(d): The completion of any Railway project(s) depends on various factors like quick land acquisition by State Government, forest clearance by officials of forest department, deposition of cost share by State Government in cost sharing projects, priority of projects, shifting of infringing utilities, statutory clearances from various authorities, geological and topographical conditions of area, law and order situation in the area of project(s) site, number of working months in a year for particular project site due to climatic conditions etc. and all these factors affect the completion time of the project(s). Railways is making all the efforts for expeditious completion of projects.

Various steps are taken by the Government for effective and speedy implementation of railway projects which include (i) prioritisation of projects (ii) substantial increase in allocation of funds on priority projects (iii) delegation of powers at field level (iv) close monitoring of progress of projects at various levels, and (v) regular follow up with State Governments and concerned authorities for expeditious land acquisition, forestry and Wildlife clearances and for resolving other issues pertaining to projects.
