PRODUCTION OF AYURVEDIC MEDICINES

656. SHRI PRATAPRAO PATIL CHIKHLIKAR:

Will the **MINISTER OF AYUSH** be pleased to state:

- (a) the details of grants released by the Government for manufacturing of Ayurvedic medicines during the last three years, State/UT-wise;
- (b) the details of proposals received for approval of grants during the last three years, State/UT-wise;
- (c) the number of such proposals pending; and
- (d) the time by which pending proposals are likely to be approved?

ANSWER THE MINISTER OF AYUSH (SHRI SARBANANDA SONOWAL)

(a) Sir. Under Centrally Sponsored Scheme of National Ayush Mission (NAM) as per the proposals received from State/UT Governments through their State Annual Action Plans, an amount of Rs. 1563.308 Lakhs has been approved under the component of quality control of Ayurveda, Siddha, Unani & Homeopathy drugs (ASU&H drugs) for different activities during last three years.

Ministry of Ayush has implemented Central Sector Scheme AYUSH Oushadhi Gunvatta Evam Uttpadan Samvardhan Yojana (AOGUSY) with total financial allocation of Rs 122.00 crores for five years. The components of the AYUSH Oushadhi Gunvatta Evam Uttpadan Samvardhan Yojana (AOGUSY) Scheme are as under;

- A. Strengthening and up-gradation of Ayush Pharmacies and Drug Testing Laboratories to achieve higher standards.
- B. Pharmacovigilance of ASU&H drugs including surveillance of misleading advertisements.
- C. Strengthening of Central and State regulatory frameworks including Technical Human Resource & Capacity Building programs for Ayush drugs.

D. Support for development of standards and accreditation/ certification of Ayush products & materials in collaboration with Bureau of Indian Standards (BIS), Quality Control of India (QCI) and other relevant scientific institutions and industrial R&D centres.

The component wise funds disbursed under the scheme AYUSH Oushadhi Gunvatta Evam Uttpadan Samvardhan Yojana (AOGUSY) are as follows:
