Will the Minister of **COMMERCE AND INDUSTRY** be pleased to state: वाणिज्य एवं उद्योग मंत्री

- (a) whether Startup Village Entrepreneurship Programme (SVEP) is being implemented in the Union Territory of Dadra and Nagar Haveli and if so, the details thereof;
- (b) whether any assistance has been provided to the rural entrepreneurs especially belonging to backward castes for setting up of local industries in the area;
- (c) if so, the details of such rural entrepreneurs particularly of the backward areas who have been benefited with the financial assistance;
- (d) the details of the employment generated through this scheme;
- (e) whether the Government proposes to implement any new scheme in the cooperative sector and rural areas in the Union Territory; and
- (f) if so, the details thereof?

ANSWER

वाणिज्य एवं उद्योग मंत्रालय में राज्य मंत्री (श्री सोम प्रकाश) THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF COMMERCE & INDUSTRY (SHRI SOM PARKASH)

(a) to (f): Start-up Village Entrepreneurship Programme (SVEP), a sub-scheme under the Deendayal Antyodaya Yojana – National Rural Livelihoods Mission (DAY-NRLM), was launched with the objective of helping rural poor from SHG ecosystem to come out of poverty by helping them to set up enterprises. Under SVEP, 2,17,979 enterprises have been supported across 29 States/UTs to set up local enterprises and has led to an approximate employment generation of 451,217 people. The total fund sanctioned under SVEP is Rs. 991.86 crore and central share is Rs. 631.70

crore. Out of this Rs. 383.22 crore as central share has been released to States/UT so far.

SVEP is a demand-based sub scheme of DAY-NRLM and there is no specific allocation for States/UTs. States/UTs submit the supplementary Annual Action Plan (AAP) for approval of SVEP Blocks. These AAPs are evaluated as per the scheme guidelines and presented to Empowered Committee (EC) for consideration.

As on date, no demand for SVEP has been received from the UT of Dadra and Nagar Haveli.
