(a) & (b): Minimum Support Price (MSP) is announced by the Government of India (GOI) at the beginning of the sowing season of crops on the basis of the recommendations of the Commission for Agricultural Costs and Prices (CACP) which determines the MSP based on the input costs and margin to farmers. FCI and State Government Agencies procure the foodgrains at MSP fixed by GOI.

MSP of Wheat and Paddy announced by GOI during the last three years and current year is as under:-
