689. SHRIMATI KAVITHA MALOTHU: DR. G. RANJITH REDDY: SHRI VENKATESH NETHA BORLAKUNTA: SHRI VIVEK NARAYAN SHEJWALKAR:

Will the Minister of CHEMICALS AND FERTILIZERS be pleased to state:

(a) whether the Government has achieved the target of opening up of 10,500 Jan Aushadhi Kendras (JAKs) in the country, if so, the details thereof, State/UT-wise including Madhya Pradesh and Telangana along with the timeframe to achieve the same;

(b) whether it is a fact that the existing JAKs are not sufficient to meet the requirements of poor, if so, the details thereof;

(c) whether the Government has considered opening of JAK in every Government hospital at the primary level, if so, the details thereof;

(d) whether it is a fact that incentives given to JAK owners are not sufficient and have been urging for enhancing the same, if so, the details thereof and the efforts made by the Government to enhance such incentives; and

(e) whether the Government has considered extending one-time incentive of Rs. 2 lakhs to OBC entrepreneurs as is being given to SC, ST, women, divyang, etc., if so, the details thereof?

ANSWER

MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF CHEMICALS AND FERTILIZERS (SHRI BHAGWANTH KHUBA)

(a): As on 30.11.2022, about 8,916 Pradhan Mantri Bhartiya Janaushadhi Kendras (PMBJKs) have been opened across the country. The target of opening 10,500 PMBJKs in the country is to be achieved by March 2025. There is, however, no state specific target for opening of PMBJKs. State/UT- wise list of PMBJKs opened across the country, including in the states of Madhya Pradesh and Telangana, is enclosed as **Annexure**.

(b): Pharmaceutical & Medical Devices Bureau of India (PMBI), the implementing agency of the scheme strive to extend the reach of the scheme by opening more Kendras as well as by enlarging the product basket for meeting the needs of the citizens. Online applications have been recently invited by PMBI from more than 3,500 blocks of 404 districts so as to further widen the network.

(c): Department of Pharmaceuticals/ PMBI periodically requests State /UT Governments/ District administrations to provide rent free space in Community Health Centre (CHC)/Primary Health Centre (PHC)/ Government Hospitals for opening PMBJP kendras. (d) & (e): The incentive provided to the Kendra owners under the scheme has been enhanced from Rs. 2.50 lakh to up to Rs. 5.00 lakh to be given @ 15% of monthly purchases made, subject to a ceiling of Rs. 15,000/- per month. Further, one-time additional incentive of Rs. 2.00 lakh (as reimbursement for IT & infrastructure expenditure) is provided to the PMBJP Kendras opened in North-Eastern States, Himalayan areas, Island territories and backward areas mentioned as aspirational district by NITI Aayog or opened by women entrepreneur, Divyang and SC & ST. Presently, there is no proposal under consideration for extending the one-time additional incentive to OBC entrepreneurs.
