Will the Minister of SKILL DEVELOPMENT AND ENTREPRENEURSHIP be pleased to state:-

- (a) whether National Skill Development Funds is helpful in increasing the employment opportunities in the country; and
- (b) if so, the number of youth trained under these schemes being implemented with this fund, particularly in the State of Bihar and other States, State/UT-wise?

**ANSWER**

(a) Yes Sir. National Skill Development Fund (NSDF) was set up in 2009 under Ministry of Finance and subsequently transferred to Ministry of Skill Development and Entrepreneurship (MSDE) in 2014. Private companies and Public Sector Undertakings (PSUs) may provide fund under their Corporate Social Responsibility (CSR) to NSDF for implementing various skill development projects through National Skill Development Corporation (NSDC).

NSDF is helpful in increasing the employment opportunities in the country. Since 2014-15 till 30.11.2022, Rs. 156.45 Cr. have been received from Private / PSU donors for imparting various skill development projects wherein 1.46 lakh and 1.14 lakh candidates have been trained and certified respectively. Out of certified candidates, around 61 thousand candidates have been placed.

(b) The State/UT-wise (including State of Bihar) number of youth trained under various skill development projects implemented from CSR funds received in NSDF, since 2014-15 upto 30.11.2022, is given at *Annexure*.
