SKILL DEVELOPMENT CENTRE UNDER PMKVY IN BIHAR

Will the Minister of SKILL DEVELOPMENT AND ENTREPRENEURSHIP be pleased to state:-

(a) the details of the Skill Development Centre set up in Bihar particularly in district Gopalganj since its inception of the scheme in 2016;

(b) the details and the number of youth trained under Pradhan Mantri Kaushal Vikas Yojana, Skill Acquisition and Knowledge Awareness for Livelihood Promotion, Standard Training Assessment and Reward and Udaan from centres in Bihar particularly in District Gopalganj;

(c) the details of the number of youth who get job opportunities or have been able to start their own small time unit; and

(d) the details of the amount sanctioned and spent in view of the above?

ANSWER

(a) Ministry of Skill Development and Entrepreneurship (MSDE) is delivering skills to the youth of the country including State of Bihar through a network of skill development centres such as Training Centers (TCs) under Pradhan Mantri Kaushal Vikas Yojana (PMKVY) including Pradhan Mantri Kaushal Kendras (PMKKs), Jan Shikshan Sansthans (JSSs) and Industrial Training Institutes (ITIs). The number of skill development centres in the State of Bihar including Gopalganj district are given below:

(b) Under PMKVY, since 2016 upto 30.09.2022, 5.40 lakh candidates have been trained/oriented in the State of Bihar including 17,603 candidates from Gopalganj district of Bihar.

Ministry has launched Adarsh Gram Skill Camp project under SANKALP (Skill Acquisition and Knowledge Awareness for Livelihood Promotion) for Recognition of Prior Learning (RPL) in identified villages across 11 States including State of Bihar. Under this project, 1,847 candidates have been benefitted in the State of Bihar.

Standard Training Assessment and Reward (STAR) Scheme, 2014 -15, was implemented by Ministry of Finance with an objective to encourage youths to takes up short duration skill development training. Under STAR, 20,862 candidates were trained in the State of Bihar.

'Udaan' (2011-18) was a special skill development program of Ministry of Home Affairs exclusively for the youth of the Jammu & Kashmir.

(c) Under PMKVY, placement opportunities have been provided to Short Term Training (STT) certified candidates, while Recognition of Prior Learning (RPL) is not linked with placements as it recognizes the existing skills of candidate. In the State of Bihar under PMKVY-STT, since 2016 upto 30.09.2022, 1.14 lakh candidates have been reported placed; out of which, 9,409 candidates were self-employed.

(d) Under PMKVY - Central component, since 2016 upto 30.11.2022, funds amounting to Rs. 419.83 Cr. have been utilized for the training in the State of Bihar. Under PMKVY – State component, since 2016 upto 30.11.2022, Rs. 36.82 Cr. were released to State of Bihar for the implementation of State component.
