Will the Minister of LABOUR AND EMPLOYMENT be pleased to state:

- (a) whether the Government has any plan in consultation with the State Government to organise Rozgar fairs at district level across the country, if so, the details thereof including the number of job fairs organised in the country including Uttar Pradesh during the last two years, district-wise and the outcome thereof along with the extent it would help the unemployed youth across the country;
- (b) the details of number of candidates provided jobs through rozgar mela including the criteria and process for selection along with the Statewise details of department and candidates who have given jobs;
- (c) whether the next cohort of the rozgar mela would be initiated and number of candidates will be given the jobs through this mela and if so, the details thereof;
- (d) the State/UT-wise details of the job fairs conducted during the last five years and the number of jobs generated and job provided through the job fairs as result thereof;
- (e) whether the Government has taken any steps to increase the number of job fairs especially in tier two and three cities, if so, the details thereof and if not, the reasons therefor; and
- (f) whether the Government has addressed the infrastructural constraints faced in rural and remote areas with respect to virtual job fairs and if so, the details thereof and if not, the reasons therefor?

ANSWER

MINISTER OF STATE FOR LABOUR AND EMPLOYMENT (SHRI RAMESWAR TELI)

(a) to (f): Job fair is one of the steps towards fulfillment of the commitment of the Government to accord highest priority to employment generation amongst youth.

Regular job fairs are being organized under various schemes by State Governments/ Ministries/ Departments etc.

Government is implementing the National Career Service (NCS) Project to provide a variety of career related services like job matching, career counselling, vocational guidance, information on skill development courses, etc. Under the NCS project, assistance is provided to States/UTs for organising job fairs with the mandate of increasing the job fairs in all states including the tier two and tier three cities. The NCS Project has a component of setting up of Model Career Centres (MCCs) in collaboration with States/Institutions to provide career related services including organising job fair, using technology at the district level. As of now, the Government has approved more than 370 Model Career Centres. Regular job fairs are being organised at MCCs. The criteria and the process of selection of candidate in the job fair varies from employer to employer.

NCS Portal (www.ncs.gov.in) has a module for organising virtual/online job fairs through MCCs to address the infrastructural constraints faced in rural and remote areas.

The details of job fairs conducted under NCS in the last five years, including the State of Uttar Pradesh is at Annexure I.

As per the information received from the State Government of Uttar Pradesh, the details of the district wise job fairs conducted during 2020-21 and 2021-22 is at Annexure II.

Apart from this, Rozgar mela events are being organised across the country by the Government and so far, about 1.47 lakh new appointees have been inducted by various Central Government Ministries/ departments/ PSUs/ autonomous bodies and banks etc.
