Will the Minister of SKILL DEVELOPMENT AND ENTREPRENEURSHIP be pleased to state:

- (a) whether the Government has achieved the objective for which Pradhan Mantri Yuva Udyamita Vikas Abhiyan (PM-YUVA) Yojana was launched;
- (b) if so, the details thereof along with the challenges faced by the Government while implementing the vojana;
- (c) the number of students who have been provided entrepreneurship education and training during each of the last three years and current year;
- (d) the achievement made by the yojana since its inception;
- (e) whether the Government has also rolled out Phase II of PM YUVA and if so, the details thereof along with total amount allocated; and
- (f) the steps taken by the Government to make the PM-YUVA Yojana successful?

ANSWER

(a) & (b) The Ministry of Skill Development and Entrepreneurship (MSDE) in association with Wadhwani Operating Foundation (WOF) launched the Pradhan Mantri Yuva Udyamita Vikas Abhiyan (PM-YUVA) Yojana on 9th November, 2016 with the objective to create an enabling ecosystem for entrepreneurship development through entrepreneurship education and training across the country. This was implemented in Institutes of Higher Learning (Colleges, Universities, Polytechnics). A total of 239 Institutes of Higher Learning were empanelled across 26 States/UTs. However, the scheme was restructured in June 2018 to include skill training institutes under MSDE, namely, Industrial Training Institutes (ITIs), Jan Shikshan Sansthan (JSS), Pradhan Mantri Kaushal Kendra (PMKK), Polytechnics. The number of beneficiaries reached through PM-YUVA Phase-I (State-wise) is given in *Annexure-I*.

Based on the learning's from PM-YUVA Phase-I, National Institute for Entrepreneurship and Small Business Development (NIESBUD) rolled out Phase-II of the PM-YUVA on its own from 2019. MSDE implemented project on Entrepreneurship Development (PM-YUVA Phase-II) through NIESBUD, at an estimated cost of Rs.12 crore upto March, 2022, in around 300 Institutes under the skill ecosystem. The aim of the Pilot Project was to promote entrepreneurship as an alternate career choice and provide mentoring support to potential and early-stage entrepreneurs by imparting entrepreneurship education and mentoring support to trainees/ beneficiaries from skill ecosystem. The project was implemented through organizations having experience in entrepreneurship development, entrepreneurship training as well as mentoring and handholding in 10 States and 2 Union Territories (viz. Assam, Bihar, Kerala, Maharashtra, Meghalaya, Tamil Nadu, Telangana, Uttar Pradesh, Uttarakhand, West Bengal, Delhi and Puducherry).

The scheme envisaged creation of 600 new and 1000 scale up enterprises, against which 1045 new enterprises were set-up and 968 existing enterprises were scaled-up. Further, the details of activities undertaken under the Pilot Project are given in *Annexure-II*.

The objectives of the pilot Project were achieved despite various challenges faced during the implementation of the project especially due to outbreak of Covid-19. The details of the total number of beneficiaries covered under the project are given in *Annexure-III*.
