## CRITERIA TO INCLUDE FESTIVALS IN HOSPITALITY SCHEME

# **806. SHRI VISHNU DAYAL RAM:**

Will the Minister of TOURISM be pleased to state:

- (a) the eligibility criteria for festivals to be included in the Domestic Promotion and Publicity including Hospitality Scheme;
- (b) whether the Bansidhar Mahotsav is eligible to be included under the Domestic Promotion and Publicity including Hospitality Scheme; and
- (c) if not, the reasons therefor?

#### **ANSWER**

## THE MINISTER OF TOURISM

(SHRI G. KISHAN REDDY)

- (a): The eligibility criteria for financial assistance by Ministry of Tourism (MoT) to States /Union Territories for fairs/festivals and tourism related events include the following:
- (i) The fairs and festivals should be selected by State Governments based on tourism potential.
- (ii) 50% of funding shall be done by the respective State Governments, except in the case of North East states where full funding is done by MoT.
- (iii) Financial assistance is provided only for creation of semi-permanent structures, production of posters, pamphlets, advertisement in newspapers and production of film, remuneration of artists, seating arrangements, lighting, sound, lodging & boarding, transportation, hiring of space and other similar activities.
- (iv) Prior approval of MoT to be taken.
- (b) & (c): No proposal for assistance has so far been received in the Ministry of Tourism for the Bansidhar Mahotsav under the Domestic Promotion and Publicity including Hospitality (DPPH) Scheme.
