- (c) whether the Government has any plan to provide low cost training to the youth through above mentioned unemployed youth; and**
- (d) if so, the details thereof?**

(a) to (d): 'Make in India' is an initiative to facilitate investment, foster innovation, build best in class infrastructure, and make India a hub for manufacturing, design, and innovation. The 'Make in India' initiative is not a state/district/city/area specific initiative, rather it is being implemented all over the country.

Under Skill India Mission, Ministry of Skill Development and Entrepreneurship (MSDE) is implementing Pradhan Mantri Kaushal Vikas Yojana (PMKVY) since 2015 with an objective to impart short duration skill development training and certification to youth across the country. PMKVY has two training components, namely, Short Term Training (STT) and Recognition of Prior Learning (RPL).
