**Will the Minister of HOME AFFAIRS be pleased to state:**

**(a) the details of encounters occurred from the cross-border infiltration attempts in the Union Territory of Jammu and Kashmir during the last one year;**

**(b) the number of terrorist infiltrators killed and caught during these encounters;**

**(c) whether the Government has received any information about the terrorist infiltration attempts from cross border and other States of the country; and**

**(d) if so, the details thereof?**

**(a) & (b): The details regarding cross-border infiltration in respect of Union Territory of Jammu and Kashmir, for the last one year i.e. January, 2021 to December, 2021, are as under:**

<b>Net Infiltration</b>	<b>Infiltrators Killed on Border</b>	<b>Infiltrators Arrested on Border</b>
<b>34</b>	<b>12</b>	<b>0</b>

**Further, there is a decline in infiltration during last three years. The details are as under:**

<b>Year</b>	<b>2019</b>	<b>2020</b>	<b>2021</b>
<b>Net Infiltration</b>	<b>138</b>	<b>51</b>	<b>34</b>

**(c) & (d): Terrorism in India is largely sponsored from across the border. Countries and agencies inimical to India keep trying to push terrorists through land routes and sea route.**
