Will the Minister of SOCIAL JUSTICE AND EMPOWERMENT be pleased to state:

- (a) the details of various schemes being run for the welfare of Senior Citizens;
- (b) the number of persons and sanitation workers belonging to Scheduled Castes, Other Backward Classes, Economically Weaker Sections and de-Notified Tribes (DNT) who have been registered on Pradhan Mantri Dakshta Aur Kushalta Sampann Hitgrahi (PM-DAKSH) portal and the details of the facilities being made available to the people registered on such portals;
- (c) the number and details of persons who have graduated from different skill training programmes in West Bengal, Maharashtra, Bihar, Rajasthan and Haryana and the number of persons who have got full time placement after evaluation in these States, district and categorywise:
- (d) the details of the programmes operated under the said schemes in Amravati, year and scheme-wise; and
- (e) the number of people of the said region benefitted from the said schemes?

ANSWER

MINISTER OF STATE FOR SOCIAL JUSTICE AND EMPOWERMENT (SUSHRI PRATIMA BHOUMIK)

- (a): Atal Vayo Abhyuday Yojana is an umbrella scheme having two components:
 - i. Integrated Programme for Senior Citizens and State Action Plan for Senior Citizens are run through budgetary provisions and these are ongoing schemes.
 - ii. There are other schemes run through funds received from Senior Citizens Welfare Fund (SCWF) which are under consideration.

(b) to (e): Department of Social Justice and Empowerment is implementing Pradhan Mantri-Dakshta Aur Kushalta Sampann Hitgrahi Yojana (PM-DAKSH) across the country from 2020-21 through 3 Corporations viz. National Scheduled Castes Finance and Development Corporation (NSFDC) for Scheduled Caste beneficiaries, National Backward Classes Finance & Development Corporation (NBCFDC) for Other Backward Classes/Economically Backward Classes/De-notified Tribes beneficiaries and National Safai Karamcharis Finance & Development Corporation (NSKFDC) for Safai Karamcharis including Waste Pickers. The details of candidates registered on PM-DAKSH portal during the financial year 2021-22 and 2022-23(as on 01.12.2022) is as under:

Post registration on the PM-DAKSH portal the eligible beneficiaries are entitled for the following facilities:-

- Eligible beneficiaries are included in the batch for providing free of cost Skill Development Training.
- ii. Stipend is provided to the eligible candidates based on their attendance through DBT.
- iii. After successful completion and assessment, the candidates are provided course completion certificates of respective training programmes.
- iv. After certification, the candidates are provided opportunities for job/self employment by the training institutes.

The details of State/UT-wise number of persons graduated/passed-out from different Skill Training Programmes and got full time placement after assessment/evaluation in the States of West Bengal, Maharashtra, Bihar, Rajasthan and Haryana under PM-DAKSH Yojana during the financial years 2021-22 and 2022-23 (As on 31.11.2022), are at <u>Annexure</u>. No training Programme under PM-DAKSH Yojana has been conducted in Amrawati.
