Details of medals won by States/Union Territories and Services Sports Control Board in 36<sup>th</sup> National Games, 2022 are given in Annexure-II. During the 36<sup>th</sup> National Games, 6 new National Records and 59 new National Games Records were set. The maximum number of National Records was set in the sport of Athletics and the maximum number of National Games Records was set in the sport of Aquatics.
- (c) & (d): The Ministry of Youth Affairs & Sports did not receive any complaints/cases regarding irregularities/ financial corruption in conduct of the 36<sup>th</sup> National Games, 2022.
- (e) & (f): Responsibility of conduct of the National Games is that of the Indian Olympic Association and the concerned host State Government.
