Will the Minister of RAILWAYS be pleased to state:

- (a) whether the Railway Board has proposed new crossing stations at Kulukkallur and Melattur stations in the Nilambur-Shoranur route under the Palakkad division;
- (b) if so, the status of the steps initiated to implement the proposal;
- (c) if not, the hurdles for granting approval for the construction of such crossing station;
- (d) whether trains have been reported to be delayed on this route due to lack of crossing stations; and
- (e) if so, the details of the measures taken to resolve the delay of trains?

There are already two block stations viz. Angadipuram and Vaniambalam and 8 non- block stations within distance of 65.80 Km between Shoranur and Nilambur.
