NO.108. SHRI SANGAM LAL GUPTA: SHRI KANAKMAL KATARA:

Will the Minister of HOUSING AND URBAN AFFAIRS be pleased to state:

- (a) the total number of cities selected under the Atal Mission for Rejuvenation and Urban Transformation (AMRUT) in the country, State/ UT-wise particularly in the States of Uttar Pradesh and Rajasthan;
- (b) the details of funds sanctioned for the cities earmarked under the said scheme, item-wise;
- (c) the total expenditure incurred on the said cities in Uttar Pradesh and Rajasthan till date;
- (d) whether there is any progress report on the developmental works completed under AMRUT for these cities, if so, the details thereof and if not, the reasons therefor;
- (e) whether there is any proposal to include more cities under AMRUT, if so, the details thereof and if not, the reasons therefor; and
- (f) whether any timeline has been fixed for the completion of said projects and if so, the details thereof?

ANSWER THE MINISTER OF HOUSING AND URBAN AFFAIRS (SHRI HARDEEP SINGH PURI)

(a) to (f): A statement is laid on the table of the House.

STATEMENT REFERRED TO IN REPLY OF PART (a) TO (f) OF THE LOK SABHA STARRED QUESTION No. *108 DUE FOR ANSWER IN THE LOK SABHA ON 09 FEBRUARY, 2023 REGARDING "CITIES COVERED UNDER AMRUT":

- (a): Under Atal Mission for Rejuvenation and Urban Transformation (AMRUT), 500 cities have been selected across all States/UTs, including 61 cities of Uttar Pradesh and 29 cities of Rajasthan respectively. State and Union Territory (UT) -wise list of AMRUT cities is placed at ANNEXURE-I.
- (b): Under AMRUT, central assistance has been allocated & funds are released to States & UTs and not to cities. States/UTs are responsible for further release of funds to cities. ₹35,990 crore is the committed Central Assistance (CA) against approved plan size of ₹77,640 crore. So far, ₹31,764 crore has been released as CA for projects. In addition, ₹1,139 crore has been released for Administrative & Other Expenses, ₹1,885 crore for reform incentive, ₹153 crore for sub-scheme on Geographical Information Systems (GIS) Based Master Plan, ₹15 crore for sub-scheme on Local Area Planning & Town Planning and ₹3,144 crore for erstwhile Jawaharlal Nehru National Urban Renewal Mission (JnNURM) projects.
- (c): So far, ₹8,195 crore have been expended in AMRUT cities of Uttar Pradesh and ₹2,771 crore in AMRUT cities of Rajasthan on AMRUT projects.

(d): AMRUT aims to provide basic amenities in 500 cities such as water supply to every household & substantial improvement in sewerage & septage management. Storm water drainage, non-motorised urban transport & development of green spaces & parks are other thrust areas. Details of sector-wise progress made in the country is as below:

137 Lakh household water tap connections have been provided, 3,348 Million Litres per Day (MLD) Water Treatment Plant capacity created and creation of another 3,385 MLD WTP capacity is in progress.

104 Lakh sewer connections/ coverage with septage management have been provided. 2,840 MLD Sewage Treatment Plant(STP) capacity has been created and creation of another 3,468 MLD STP capacity is in progress.966 KM drains have been constructed, 962 KM Drains are in progress. 2,952 Water Logging Points have been eliminated & elimination of 790 Water Logging Points is in progress.

420 KM pedestrian walkways, 37.82 KM dedicated cycle tracks and 2,80,472 Sqm parking area have been developed. 4,506-acre green area has been developed.

Details of sector-wise progress made in AMRUT cities of Rajasthan and Uttar Pradesh is placed at ANNEXURE-II.

(e) & (f): No Sir, there is no proposal to add more cities under AMRUT Scheme as AMRUT has been subsumed under AMRUT 2.0 Mission, launched on 01stOctober 2021. Water supply to households in all statutory towns & cities is major focus of AMRUT 2.0. AMRUT projects shall be centrally funded till 31stMarch 2023.
