STATEMENT REFERRED TO IN REPLY PART (a) to (d) of LOK SABHA STARRED QUESTION No. 117 REGARDING CLEANLINESS CAMPAIGN DUE FOR ANSWER ON 09 FEBRUARY 2023.

- (a) & (b) Ministry of Civil Aviation participated in the Special Campaign 2.0 for disposal of pending matters and Swachhata during 02nd-31st October, 2022 with the objective of institutionalising Swachhata and reducing pendency in Government offices. Apart from the Ministry, all attached offices, including field offices, Autonomous Bodies and PSUs participated in the campaign. The cleanliness campaign was conducted at 134 locations across the country. During the campaign, a total of 43224 physical files were reviewed, out of which 32919 physical files were weeded out, 42,786 square feet of space freed and revenue of Rs. 2,65,91,760/- generated from scrap disposal. Additionally, 582 Public Grievances and 145 Public Grievance Appeals were also disposed during the campaign.
- (c) & (d) The project work at Kanpur Airport is likely to be completed in February, 2023. Flight operations can start from the new terminal of Kanpur airport as and when the work is completed and the Terminal Building commissioned.
