- (b) if so, the details thereof;

**STATEMENT REFERRED TO IN REPLY TO LOK SABHA
STARRED QUESTION NO. 128 FOR 10TH FEBRUARY, 2023**

(a) to (d) National Covid-19 vaccination was started across the Country on 16th January 2021, and is continuing till date. Free vaccination is provided in Government Covid Vaccination Centers (CVCs) to all eligible beneficiaries above 12 years of age. Further, Precaution dose is also provided free of cost to all above 18 years of age since 15th July 2022 in Government Covid Vaccination Centers.

As on 6th February 2023, a total of 220.57 crore vaccine doses have been administered across the country. A total of 97% of the age group 12 years and above have received 1st dose and 90% have received both the doses. A total of 22.81 crore Precaution doses have also been administered across the country. State/UT wise coverage in beneficiaries above 12 years of age as on 6th February 2023 is at annexure-1.
