*139. SHRI RAJIV PRATAP RUDY:

Will the Minister of Women and Child Development be pleased to state:

- (a) whether One Stop Centres (OSCs) have been established for the protection of women in the country, if so, the details thereof;
- (b) the number of OSCs that are currently functional, State/UT-wise and district-wise including Saran, Bihar;
- (c) whether there are adequate number of professionals in each OSC in the country, if so, the details thereof along with the monitoring mechanism to ensure proper functioning of these centres;
- (d) whether the Government proposes to increase the number of OSCs, if so, the details thereof indicating the total amount of funds allocated for the purpose;
- (e) the total number of women who have been assisted/benefited by the OSCs, State/UT-wise during the last two years; and
- (f) whether there are any monitoring mechanisms in place to put a check upon them post-assistance and if so, the details thereof?

ANSWER

MINISTER OF WOMEN AND CHILD DEVELOPMENT (SHRIMATI SMRITI ZUBIN IRANI)

(a) to (d): A Statement is laid on the Table of the House.

STATEMENT REFERRED TO IN REPLY TO LOK SABHA STARRED QUESTION NO. 139* FOR ANSWER ON 10.02.2023 ASKED BY SHRI RAJIV PRATAP RUDY REGARDING 'ONE STOP CENTRES'

- (a) & (b): Yes Sir, the Government has been implementing scheme of One Stop Centre (OSC) w.e.f. 01.04.2015 to provide integrated support and assistance to women affected by violence and in distress, both in private and public spaces under one roof and facilitate an integrated range of services including medical aid, legal aid and advice, temporary shelter (for a maximum period of 5 days), police assistance and psycho -social counseling to needy women. Now the OSC scheme has been included as a component of sub-scheme 'Sambal' under Mission Shakti. Presently, 733 OSC's are operational in 36 States/ UTs. In Bihar, one OSC is functional in each district including Saran. The State/ UT-wise and district wise details of functional OSCs is at Annexure-I.
- **(c):** In order to equip the OSC's to provide the integrated services to the women, the scheme guidelines provide for hiring of personnels including case workers, paralegal personnel/lawyer, paramedical personnel, psychosocial counsellors etc by the state government/UT's. The guidelines of Mission Shakti, however, do not envisage creation of regular posts for One Stop Centres. Government of India provides financial assistance to states / UTs for hiring of manpower for functioning of the components of Mission Shakti including OSCs.

As per the scheme guidelines, District/ State authorities are mandated for monitoring, coordinating and mid-course correction for effective implementation of the scheme. The Ministry at various levels also reviews the scheme, from time to time, to ensure effective functioning of these centres by issuing advisories to States Governments/ UT Administrations and conducting meetings, video conferencing etc with all concerned functionaries. Further, an online platform namely Sakhi Dashboard is also available for monitoring of its implementation.

- **(d):** Based on encouraging results of this initiative and benefits to women, the Government has decided to open 300 more OSCs, in a phased manner, in the districts having higher rate of crime against women or having bigger geographical area, preferably in aspirational districts. Accordingly provision for Rs.562.00 crore has been made for the sub-scheme 'Sambal' under Mission Shakti for the current Financial Year 2022-23.
- **(e):** The State /UT wise number of women assisted / benefitted by the OSCs, is at **Annexure-II.**
- **(f):** As per the scheme guidelines, District/ State authorities are mandated for monitoring, coordinating and mid-course correction for effective implementation of the scheme. Further, an online platform namely Sakhi Dashboard is also available for monitoring of its implementation. The OSC functionaries also follow up with the survivors / women through various channels after they have availed the services.
