STATEMENT REFERRED TO IN REPLY TO PART (a) TO (c) OF LOK SABHA STARRED QUESTION NO. *145 (5th POSITION) FOR 13TH FEBRUARY, 2023 REGARDING ‘CSR SPENDING BY CPSEs’.

(a) & (b): The broad framework for Corporate Social Responsibility (CSR) has been provided under Section 135 of the Companies Act, 2013 (‘Act’), Schedule VII of the Act and Companies (CSR Policy) Rules, 2014. Under the Act, CSR is a Board driven process and the Board of the company is empowered to plan, decide, execute and monitor the CSR activities of the company based on the recommendation of its CSR Committee.

The CSR framework is disclosure based and CSR mandated companies are required to file details of CSR activities annually in the MCA21 registry. However, the companies are not required to report the allocation of CSR funds in the Financial Year (FY). All data related to CSR filed by companies in MCA21 registry is available in public domain at www.csr.gov.in. On the basis of the filings made by the companies in the MCA 21 registry, the details of CSR spent by top 25 (CSR expenditure-wise) Central Public Sector Enterprises (CPSEs) during the FY 2016-17, 2017-18, 2018-19, 2019-20 and 2020-21 are given below:
