- (b) No Sir, The performance Audit Report of Comptroller and Auditor General of India
- & (c) laid on the table of the Parliament House in 2013 in their report had stated that 92 protected monuments were missing. However, Archaeological Survey of India (ASI) has traced out 68 monuments and 24 are not yet traced. List of these monuments is at **Annexure-II.**
 - (d) The monuments are inspected by ASI officials/officers from time to time to assess their condition and accordingly annual works programme is drawn. Thereafter, conservation, preservation and maintenance works are taken up according to need priority and availability of resources.
