**PLACEMENT TARGET UNDER PMKVY**

DR. PRITAM GOPINATHRAO MUNDE:

Will the Minister of SKILL DEVELOPMENT AND ENTREPRENEURSHIP be pleased to state:-

- (a) whether the Government has fixed any placement target under the Pradhan Mantri Kaushal Vikas Yojana Phase-3 (PMKVY 3.0), during the last three years;
- (b) if so, the details thereof, State-wise particularly in Maharashtra;
- (c) the details of the placement percentage attained across the country at an aggregate and State level specifically under the PMKVY Phase 3 (PMKVY 3.0) during the years 2021 and 2022 particularly in Maharashtra;
- (d) whether PMKVY 3.0 has been able to achieve the set targets for imparting quality skills in various States, particularly in Maharashtra; and
- (e) if so, the details thereof, if not, the reasons therefor and the corrective steps taken by the Government in this regard?

MUNDE REGARDING PLACEMENT TARGET UNDER PMKVY**

(a) to (c) Ministry of Skill Development and Entrepreneurship (MSDE) had launched the Pradhan Mantri Kaushal Vikas Yojana (PMKVY 3.0) on 15.01.2021 with an objective to deliver skills to youth of the country to make them employable for better livelihood. PMKVY 3.0 was a demand driven scheme; hence no placement target was fixed by the Government. However, MSDE through various initiatives had facilitated the placement of the short term certified candidates.

Under PMKVY 3.0, training was imparted through Short Term Training (STT), Recognition of Prior Learning (RPL), Customized Crash Course Programme for COVID Warriors and Skill Hubs Initiative. Placement was not mandatory component of the scheme. However, placement opportunities were facilitated to STT certified candidates. Further, Rozgar Melas and Apprenticeship Melas were organized to facilitate the placements of the certified candidates.

(d) and (e) Yes, Sir. PMKVY 3.0 has been able to achieve the set targets for imparting quality skills in various States, including Maharashtra. The Ministry had taken various steps to ensure quality training under PMKVY 3.0 like offering industry linked demand driven National Skill Qualification Framework (NSQF) courses, training through accredited and affiliated training centers, training delivery and assessment through certified trainers and assessors, compulsory Aadhaar enabled Bio-metric attendance system, rigorous monitoring through physical and virtual inspection visits, and end-to-end training life-cycle management through Skill India Portal (SIP).

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
