Growth in Fish Production

Will the **Minister of FISHERIES, ANIMAL HUSBANDRY AND DAIRYING**

- (a) whether there has been 20 times growth in the fish production sector after independence;
- (b) if so, the details thereof;
- (c) whether Pradhan Mantri Matsya Sampada Yojana is going to be implemented in the year 2024-25; and
- (d) if so, the details thereof?

ANSWER

(a) to (d) : A Statement is laid on the Table of the House

Statement referred to in reply to the Lok Sabha Starred Question No 192 put in by Shri Rattan Lal Kataria , Honourable Member of Parliament for answer on 14th March, 2023 regarding “Growth in Fish Production”

(a) and (b): The total fish production in the country has registered a steady growth from 7.52 lakh tonnes in 1950–51 to 162.48 lakh tonnes in 2021–22, registering more than 21 times increase in the overall fish production after independence.

(c) and (d) : Department of Fisheries, Ministry of Fisheries, Animal Husbandry and Dairying is currently implementing a flagship scheme namely “Pradhan Mantri Matsya Sampada Yojana (PMMSY)” with estimated investment of ₹20,050 crores in fisheries sector for a period of 5 years with effect from the financial year 2020-21 to financial year 2024-25 in all States/Union Territories. Under PMMSY, the Department of Fisheries, Ministry of Fisheries, Animal Husbandry and Dairying during the financial years 2020-21, 2021-22 and 2022-23 has accorded approvals to the proposals of 35 States and Union Territories and other implementing agencies with total outlay of Rs. 12030.06 crores.
