## \*204. SHRIMATI CHINTA ANURADHA:

- (a) whether it is a fact that the Government's SAMARTH- Scheme for Capacity Building in Textile Sector (SCBTS) has achieved its target of training over 10 lakh persons (9 lakh persons in organized & 1 lakh persons in traditional sectors) over the period of 3 years (2017-2020);
- (b) if so, the details thereof, State-wise and if not, the reasons therefor;
- (c) whether the said scheme which was stopped due to Covid-19 induced lockdown has been restarted;
- (d) if so, the details of places, State-wise; and
- (e) if not, the reasons therefor?

## STATEMENT REFERRED TO IN REPLY TO PARTS (a) to (e) OF THE LOK SABHA STARRED QUESTION NO. \*204 TO BE ANSWERED ON 15.03.2023

(a) & (b): Scheme for Capacity Building in Textile Sector (Samarth) was formulated as a demand driven skilling scheme and approved on 20<sup>th</sup> December, 2017 with the target to train 10 lakh persons in 3 years.

Subsequently, the tenure of implementation of the scheme was extended upto March, 2024 with an outlay of Rs. 390 crore upto 2023-24. 1,53,047 beneficiaries have been trained so far under the scheme.

The implementation of scheme was impacted due to Covid-19 disruptions and time taken to streamline the processes/ procedures for direct participation of textile industry units for ensuring placement linkage and implementation through end to end digital platform.

State/UT-wise details of total beneficiaries under Samarth scheme is given at Annexure-I.

(c) to (e): Covid-19 pandemic had largely impacted the implementation of training programmes under Samarth. The training programmes have been restarted post Covid-19 induced lockdowns. State / UT-wise details of places where Samarth scheme is implemented is at **Annexure-II**.
