(a) & (b): Under the Pilot Scheme for Setting up Incubation Centers in Apparel Manufacturing (SIAM), three projects were sanctioned by the Government. The details of incubation centers supported by the Government grants are as under: -

No proposal under the Pilot Scheme of SIAM was received from Maharashtra.

(c) & (d): Third party evaluation study of the Scheme was conducted by Arun Jaitley National Institute of Financial Management, Faridabad in the year 2020. The study concluded *inter-alia* that the scheme is a promising one and needs more time, larger coverage and more investments for evolving to its full bloom. It was felt that no less than 5-7 years may be required for an acceptable level of performance of Incubation Centres towards upskilling entrepreneurs and/or designpreneurs.

(e): With a view to have the entire value chain from spinning to Ready Made garments including plug and play facility of textile sector under one roof and to provide integrated facilities of skilling, incubation centre, testing labs, common utilities, social infrastructure, the Government has approved setting up 7 (Seven) PM Mega Integrated Textile Region and Apparel (PM MITRA) Parks in Greenfield/Brownfield sites in partnership with the willing State Governments. The Scheme would lead to creation of a modern, integrated large scale, world class industrial infrastructure with a budgetary outlay of Rs.4,445 crore for a period 2021-22 to 2027-28.
